Many people feel that winning is the only asset in football, however, Mr. Ditter taught his players sportsmanship and how to accept defeat like men.

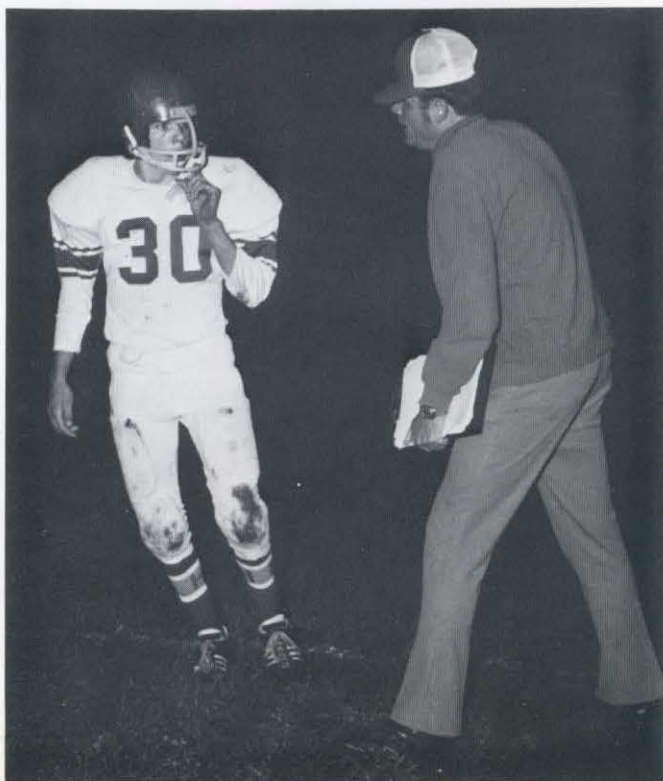

Superintendent of Schools, John M. Miller, introduced the class.

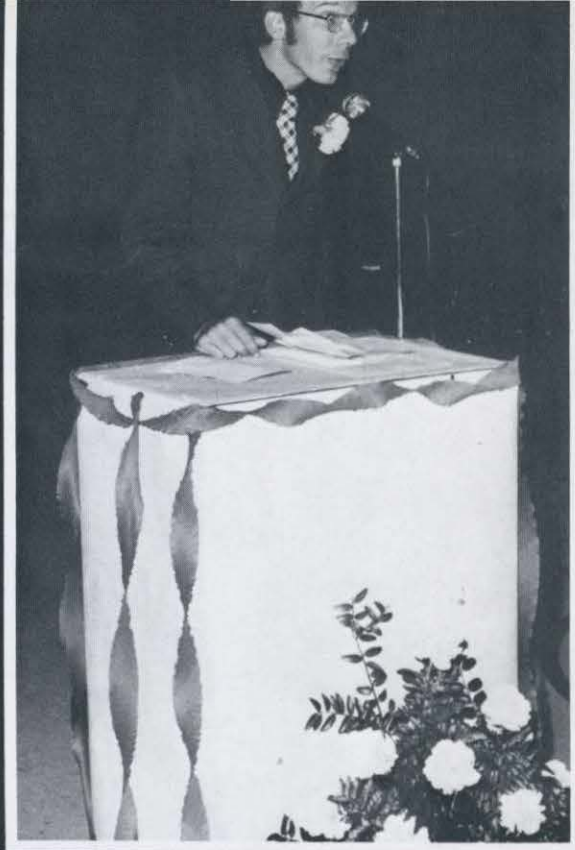
Clarence Widhalm was also recognized as an honorary member of the class.
