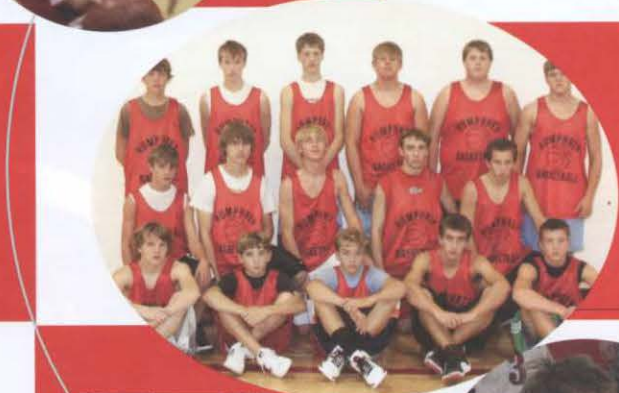

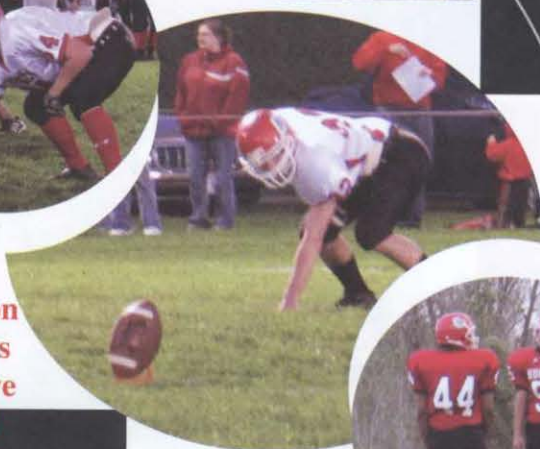

Senior, Eric Ternus said of the season, "I'm happy with the wins this season, but I wish we would have had more."

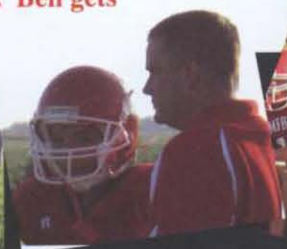
Senior, Ethan Preister, commented, "I'm really proud of how much energy we had this season. More wins would have been nice, but we tried our best every game."

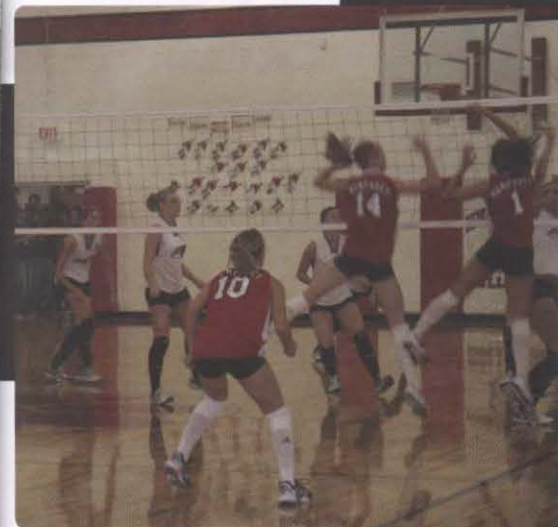

Congratulations to the Lady Dawgs on their incredible journey to the state tournament.

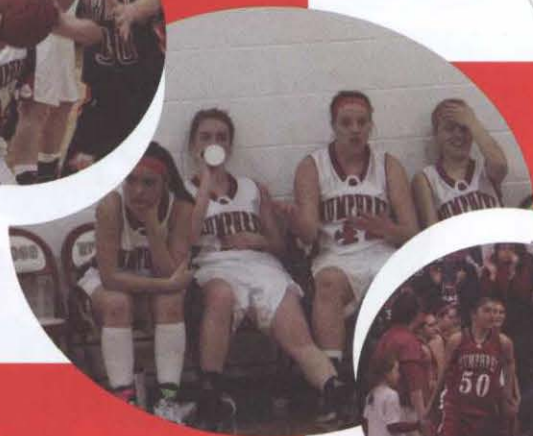

The track team at HHS was successful this year, sending three individuals to state in five events and one group event. Coach Frauendorfer had this to say about the girl's team:

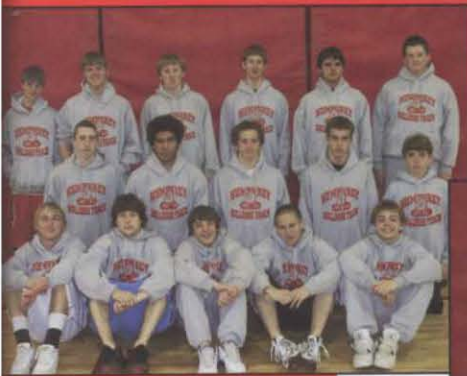

Coach Bender felt the boys worked hard and dividends will start rolling in soon. He had this to say of the boys:

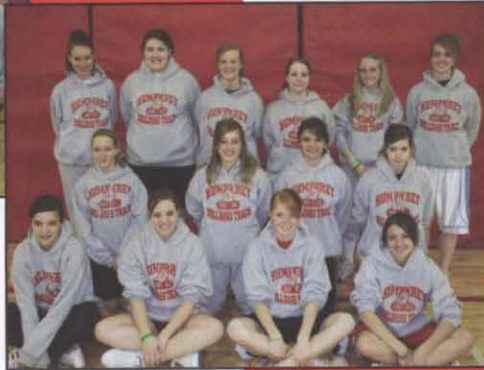

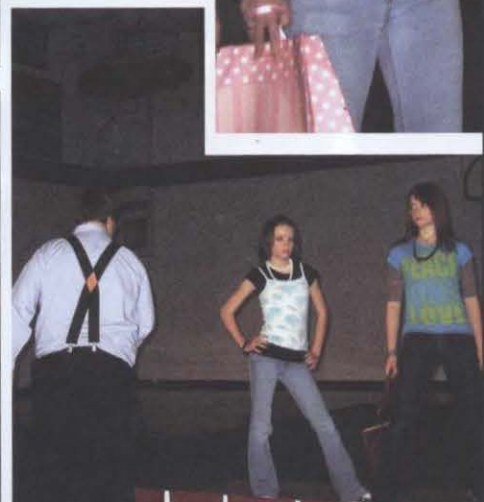
