Humphrey Public School 2025-2026 Preschool Acceptance Criteria

Application process – Parents/Guardians MUST deliver the application to Mr. King or Mr. Rathje in the office, if neither are available, please deliver to Amanda Veik. Applications will be marked with the date and time as they are received. Mailed in forms WILL NOT be accepted. Students will be selected based on criteria below, including order/date of applications received (first come/first served). You MUST re-apply for Preschool every year.

District student will be interpreted as a resident with a current address in Humphrey School District at the time of application. Applications will be marked and dated only if residence is established.

If a family exits the program or forfeits acceptance, they must reapply if they decide at a later date to get back on the enrollment waiting list.

Students who turn five on or before July 31, 2020 are not eligible for preschool unless so determined by an IEP team. 4-Year Old = Born August 1, 2020 – July 31, 2021

3-Year Old = Born August 1, 2021 – July 31, 2022

Priority #1

District verified students ages 3 or 4 by July 31.

Priority #2

District students whose family income qualifies them for participation in the federal free and reduced lunch program.

Priority #3

District students whose parents are younger than 18 or who have not completed high school.

Priority #4

District students <u>age 3 or 4 by July 31</u> in order of applications received, date-time with siblings that attend Humphrey Public School.

Priority #5

District students <u>age 3 or 4 by July 31</u> in order of applications received, date-time. (District students will have priority until May 30).

Priority #6

Out of district students <u>age 3 or 4 by July 31</u> with older siblings currently enrolled in grades K-12 and children of Humphrey Public School employees. If you are an Out-of-District student, parents must sign the Option Enrollment form for their upcoming Kindergarten year to be eligible for preschool.

Priority #7

Out of district students <u>age 3 or 4 by July 31</u> (in order of applications received-date and time). If you are an Out-of-District student, parents must sign the Option Enrollment form for their upcoming Kindergarten year to be eligible for preschool.

Priority #8

Kindergarten eligible students who remain 5 years old after January 1, 2026 may attend 4-year old preschool.

NOTE: Humphrey Public School will use discretion for out of district verified pre-school students for the 2025-2026 school year.

***Transportation** is provided to those preschoolers who qualify under priorities 1, 2 or 3. District discretion will be used for students that qualify under priorities 4 and 5. No transportation will be provided for out-of-district preschool students.

Acceptance letters will be emailed to parents after the May 30, 2025 registration deadline. Parents will have until June 6th, 2025 to accept their spot for preschool.
