



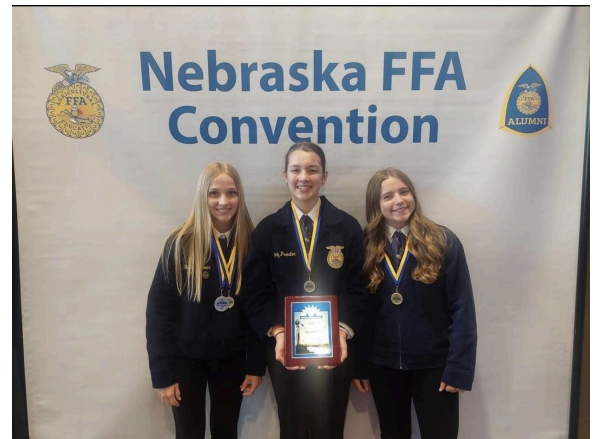

Speaking of State FFA, congratulations to our Agriscience team who placed 1st at the State Convention. Individually, Shelby Hemmer placed 2nd. Brenna and Emily from Archangels placed 4th and 10th respectfully. Together their scores placed them 1st out of 553 competitors on 141 teams. This is the largest Career Development event at the State Convention. Again, congratulations to Shelby and her teammates.



Congratulations to our Bulldog Speech team on an outstanding season. They represented Humphrey High well at the state speech meet with multiple individuals placing in the top six in their events. Congratulations to the entire team and their coaches!

I wanted to provide a short update regarding the facility project. At this point in time the architect is working closely with the engineering teams to finalize facility specifications. 
