I hope all of you have had some time to do something that you enjoy and spend it with people who you enjoy. The start of the 2024-2025 school year is just a few short weeks away. I wanted to take the first newsletter of the school year to bring a few things to your attention.

- Make sure that all fall sports participants have their sports physicals completed before August 12th. Student cannot participate until they have their physical.
- 7th grade orientation will be held at HHS starting at 6:00pm on August 8th. This should not take any longer than about an hour.
- Please take the time to review the Student/Parent handbook for this academic year. There are a few things to point out. 1. Students who are ineligible are able to become eligible right away if their grades are brought up (with my approval). 2. I will send out a warning list for the D/F list every Friday (via Connect5) to parents. The D/F list will be released every Monday. 3. Cell phones are to be placed in the student's locker. I am going to be a stickler about cell phones (more so than I have been).
- As activities begin, if you would like to allow your student to go to a school activity to watch, such as football, volleyball, cross country, and softball. Please complete the following. 1. Call the office to allow your student to be released for that activity. I ask that you do this at least a day before the event. 2. Have your student complete a yellow release form by the teachers so that any class work is understood. I am asking the students to complete these steps to eliminate any confusion in the office, classroom, and cafeteria. Please do not call the day of the activity to have your student released to go watch a meet. Please plan ahead of time.
- Tech Bootcamp is now to be completed online. You will still need to come to school and pay for your child's computer fee along with sign the computer agreement.
- Spanish classes will now be offered in house starting this year. Mrs. Jill Preister will now be teaching Spanish.
- Please welcome Mr. Travis Freisen to HHS this school year. Most of you already know Mr. Freisen as he has been our head track coach for some time and has also helped with basketball. Mr. Freisen will teach strength and conditioning, Jr high social studies, and a few other classes. We are excited to have Mr. Freisen this year.

Similar to past years, we will be implementing our school wide screeners this year. This is a way in which we provide tier one support to all students in our building. We utilize this information to provide insight on whether our students may benefit from some additional social and emotional support. We will continue to utilize our evidence based curriculum, Positive Action, for social and emotional learning where all students K-12 will receive lessons on health and well-being, social skills, emotional regulation, and more.

Elementary: We will be implementing more small groups this upcoming school years. Small groups are just like small groups in a classroom where information and activities occur with smaller number of students to enhance the overall retention of the information. Additionally, we are able to target certain skills more directly when students are grouped strategically based on areas of strengths and needs. All elementary students will also receive instruction on social and emotional learning each week to aid in their overall development as a person. This is through the Positive Action curriculum we purchased with our mental health grant last summer.

Junior High: This seems to be an extremely challenging couple of years for students. Please, make sure to continue to check in on their well-being throughout the school year. Students, please, reach out to me if there is something you feel like you need to talk about. That's why I'm here. Please, also remember the importance of knowing what your child is doing on social media. Students, please, make sure you are practice safe technology use while on social media and the internet. Lastly, remember that you all are uniquely and wonderfully made. We love what each and every one of you bring to our school and are so excited for another school year!


