At our regulary scheduled September board meeting the Humphrey Public School Board of Education approved the budget and tax request for the 2024-2025 school year. The school determines the budget and tax request based on information received from Platte and Madison counties in regards to land valuations and then reviews planned costs and expenditures for the upcoming school year to determine the tax request. The overall cent levy for this year came in at \$0.3450, which is a decrease compared to the cents levied last year at \$0.3781. The goal for our board and I is to be as fiscally responsible as possible whil providing the best education for our students.
