If we decide to go to a Remote learning environment, Humphrey Public School will follow this Remote Learning Plan.

Students in Grades K-6 would follow our current 2020-2021 academic class schedule at their scheduled times.

Core Classes (English/Language Arts & Math) - Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

- Students will meet “live” via ZOOM during their scheduled time on **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.**
- Students will be split into three groups at each grade level for both ELA and Math.
- Teachers will communicate with parents on which group their child will be in.

- On Tuesday and Thursday, core class teachers would be available to ZOOM for assistance during their class time.
- No additional assignments on Tuesday and Thursday.

Science & Social Studies - Tuesday

- Students will meet “live” via ZOOM during their scheduled time on **Tuesday.**
- Students will be split into three groups at each grade level for both Science and Social Studies.
- Teachers will communicate with parents on which group their child will be in.

2020-2021 Humphrey Public School Grades 7-12 Remote Learning Plan

If we decide to go to a Remote learning environment, Humphrey Public School will follow this Remote Learning Plan. Students in Grades 7-12 would follow our current 2020-2021 academic class schedule at their scheduled times.

Core Classes (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies)

- Students will meet “live” during their scheduled time on **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday**.
- The teachers would be live via ZOOM during their scheduled class time and students would be required to attend via ZOOM.
- On Tuesday and Thursday, core class teachers would be available to ZOOM for assistance during their class time.
- No additional assignments on Tuesday and Thursday.

Elective Classes

- Students will meet “live” during their scheduled time on **Tuesday and Thursday**.
- The teachers would be live via ZOOM during their scheduled class time, and students would be required to attend via ZOOM.
- On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, elective class teachers would be available to ZOOM for assistance during their class time.
- No additional assignments on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Attendance

- If a student is not in attendance for your class while you are hosting a virtual class, they will be considered absent. If your class does not meet virtually, you will mark the students “present” or “in attendance.”

Grading

- For all classes, grading would be done on a normal grading scale as if we were in session at school. If a worksheet has 100 problems and a student misses 14 problems, that student would receive an 86%. If another student does the same worksheet and misses 2, that student would earn a 98%.
- Students not completing assignments would have a zero in the grade book for that assignment until it is completed.
 - Students who turn in assignments late (all assignments would be due at midnight the Sunday after it is assigned) would receive the same “penalty” for the late grade in every class. Each week the assignment is late, 10 percent will be deducted from the final grade. For example, if a worksheet has 100 problems, and the student gets all of the problems correct, but the student turned the assignment in late, that student would receive a 90% for a grade. If another student turns in the same assignment late and gets 75 of the problems right, that student would receive a 65% for a grade.

Presentation

- All teachers will be using Google Classroom as their online platform. There will be 20-25 minutes (20 preferable) to give direct instruction / lecture and then the other 20-25 minutes would be work time/interaction with the students.
- The teacher's delivery of instruction can vary. Teachers may break it into two 10-minute sections or maybe three 5-minute sections and give interaction / work time in between. It may look different for each teacher for each day.
